In the Spring of 2018, 8 Danish manufacturing companies went through the REMODEL programme. Now, we've published the toolkit for anyone to use. Especially manufacturers of hardware can take advantage of this new resource to radically rethink how they innovate and scale

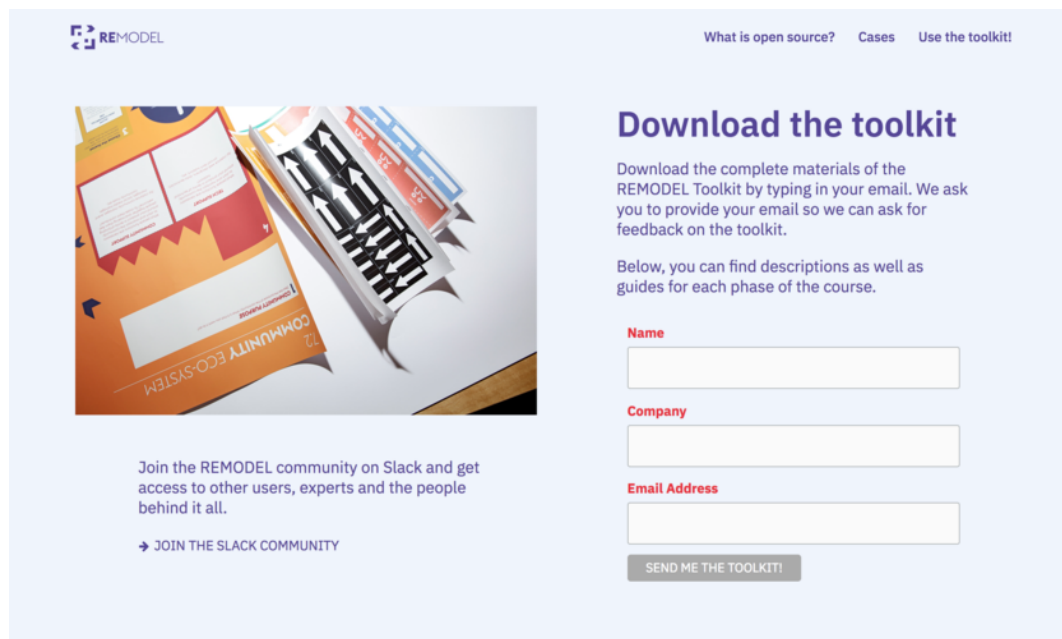
their business through open source.

available, namely the Creative Commons Attribution-ShareAlike (CC BY-SA) license. In other words: Please take what we've made and make it your own, build on it, share it, sell it – do whatever you want with it. All we ask is that you mention where the originals came from (including credits to those third-party works who we've built some of our elements on). This is our way of building assets that will continue to pay value forward to coming generations of co-creators.
